In Oct. I thought I would try the luck at an Elk, I was not fortunate enough to have drawn a tag, so I picked an area that was known to have Elk populatic but was still closed to hunting. Again after the third day out third attempt i was ablr to work as I wanted it to work. It worked very well once the grunt was mastere and I was able to get a break in the high note squeal. I could have taken the Elk with a 357 or 44 mag with out any problem had I had a tag and the had been open.

I have only had a chance to test the field call on mule deer. After sneaking to within 35 yards of a small 24" buck, I decided to play with him a bit. After I decided to spook him, and while he was running away, I made the "Mew". The buck stopped dead in his tracks, turned broadside, and looked back, at about 75 yards. Again while running across the hillside below me at about 200 yards I gave another "Mew". He stopped broadside & looked. He would have been easy to shoot any of these times, had I cared to.

Having just started a late whitetail season, I look forward to trying this all in one call on them too. The instructional cassette is a definite must, and is extremely helpful in training the different sounds possible with the call.
